


With a costume slide show and actually there were more slideshows on: art with landscaping, budding artists, crazy creatures which was really crazy. They all were fun and creative.

The 50 square mile part of yellowstone where you can get away with murder

Yellowstone National Park. Home to some of the country's most popular tourist attractions and the only place in the country you can legally get away with murder, even if all the evidence points to you. Yellowstone, like all national parks, is federal land. It has parts in Montana, Wyoming and Idaho but remains a federal district of Wyoming. The section of the park in which you can get away with murder is uninhabited and about 50 square miles in size. The reason for this is complicated so I'll do my best to explain it.

The Constitution requires that all trials be held in the state in which the crime was committed. The sixth amendment entitles the defendant to a trial with a jury consisted of jurors from the same state and district in which the crime was committed. Because this part of the park lies in Idaho, but is part of Yellowstone, which is in Wyoming, but is federal land, neither Idaho, Wyoming, or Montana has jurisdiction. Also, since the area is completely uninhabited by people, it is impossible to form a jury of any kind. This grants legal and constitutional immunity from being tried and sent to prison for almost any crime.

But what about international criminals? Or war criminals? The criminals that are being pursued by foreign governments because they committed a crime in a different country? If an international criminal from Morocco, for example, were to commit a crime such as murder in this section of Yellowstone while being pursued by the Moroccan government, what would happen? Murder is obviously a violation of US laws, so that Moroccan criminal would be breaking US laws. The US Government is allowed to prosecute aliens for federal crimes in the US, but there can't be a constitutional jury, as discussed earlier. I don't want to get into the constitution applying to aliens because that is too controversial. but since that criminal would be wanted in Morocco, an agreement would have to be reached. The Moroccan government would have to prove that the criminal had committed a crime in their country in order to prosecute him there. The US has a much more stable government than that of fragile Morocco's, so prosecution here and jailing there is a better option. In most cases, criminal aliens are sent back to their home country to be tried and prosecuted. I really can't say for sure what would happen in this situation because I'm not a lawyer. A veggie burger!

INGREDIENTS

- Three tablespoons of olive oil
- ¾ cup fresh corn kernels or frozen, thawed
- 6 mushrooms, finely chopped
- 2 scallions, finely chopped
- ½ red bell pepper, finely chopped
- 1 garlic clove, finely chopped
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- Dash cayenne pepper
- ½ cup chopped fresh spinach
- 1 carrot, peeled and grated
- 1 small potato, peeled and grated
- 1 egg white
- Salt and pepper
- ½ cup fresh bread crumbs
- 1 cup plain yogurt
- 2 tablespoons chopped fresh mint

DIRECTIONS

In a large skillet heat 1 tablespoon oil over medium high heat. Stir in corn, mushrooms, scallions, and bell pepper. Cook for 3-4 minutes. Add garlic, cumin and cayenne and cook for 30 seconds. Remove from heat and stir in spinach. Add carrot and potato and stir to combine. Add egg white and season with salt and pepper. Stir in enough bread crumbs so that the mixture holds together. Shape mixture into 6 disks and place on a plate. Chill for 1 hour. Heat 2 tablespoons olive oil in non-stick skillet and cook veggie burgers until golden on each side. In a small bowl mix together yogurt and mint.
